2009 CRYSTAL FROLICS SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Manager check in (Before your first game) at Tournament headquarters is mandatory. BECKER PARK
2. All games will be played under USSSA rules with the following exceptions:
 - a. 3-2 count 2nd strike dead runners CANNOT advance.
 - b. Courtesy runners are NOT allowed
 - c. Teams must start and finish with 10 or 11 players replacement players are needed for injury or ejection.
3. Run Rule. 15 after 5innings-- 10 after six innings
4. Home runs: Gold 3 home runs --Silver 2 home runs. Outs after limit is reached. HIT +SIT
5. Unsportsmanlike conduct: ANY TEAM PERSONNEL CITED FOR UNSPORTMANLIKE CONDUCT BY AN UMPIRE OR TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL, BEFORE DURING OR AFTER A GAME, WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE WITH ANY TEAM IN ANY FASHION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TOURNAMENT.
6. Any player using a bat NOT approved for this Tournament will be cited for UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT ALONG WITH TEAM MANAGER. See rule #5
7. All players must be on an official USSSA ON LINE roster or League roster signed by League Director And turned into Tournament Director. NO PICK UP PLAYERS ALLOWED. Players on FROZEN roster can play for that team ONLY.
8. Time Limit No new inning after 55 minutes for Silver games
No new inning after 65 minutes for Gold and Silver games at BECKER+CENTRAL
9. If the tournament has to be postponed do to inclement weather, it will be the managers responsibility to check in at Tournament Headquarters (Becker Park) for information from Director or Umpire in Chief
10. The Tournament Director reserves the right to adjust the tournament format to complete tournament in A timely fashion. Due to unusual circumstances. This could mean going to a ONE PITCH format, length of games, dropping the losers bracket or any game rules as he see fit. DIRECTOR has final say in all Tournament matters.
11. Expense Reimbursements will be issued to the team manager ONLY. If manager is NOT available a check will be mailed. Teams must play all scheduled games unless approved by T.D. Failure to play games as scheduled could result in loss of travel expense payment.
12. GRACE PERIOD: A 5 minute grace period will be allowed to start play with the minimum number of Players (10) for the first scheduled game at each field,(Thur-Sun) Thereafter GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME. Assume all games are on time, unless told so by the Tournament Director or Umpire in Chief.
13. Home team will be determined by coin flip prior to each game and will provide an adult for the official book. Umpires decision final. NO protests allowed. Player eligibility will be handle by T.D.
14. Parking around Becker and Welcome Parks may be difficult at times during special FROLICS events Especially during the parade on SUNDAY. Please allow yourself enough time to move onto and off Becker and Welcome Fields for scheduled games.
15. Tie games AFTER the time limit will start with last out on 2nd base, ONE out and will use a ONE PITCH count until games are completed. INTERNATIONAL RULE

16. The Crystal Frolics Committee and Recreation Department has put together s celebration that can be Enjoyed by all. Between games stop by and enjoy some of the many attractions and food booths Available in the Crystal area. Further info can be obtained by calling 763-531-0052.
17. TEAM PERSONNEL MUST REMAIN INSIDE THE DUGOUT AREA. BATTER, ON DECK BATTER IN THE HOLD, AND BASE COACHES ARE ONLY ONES ALLOWED OUTSDIE FENCED DUGOUT AREA AT BECKER AND CENTRAL PARKS.
