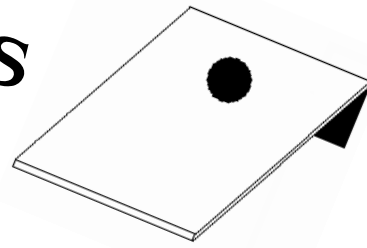


# Crystal Frolics

## Baggo Tournament



### Game Basics

Teams consist of 2-4 players any Gender

Boards are placed 20 feet apart

Team members must throw directly across from each other from opposite boards

Opponents alternate throwing bags until all 8 bags have been tossed

Highest scoring team from each turn throws first, if tied it goes to previous round.

**NEW for 2011 – after each game in a match is complete partners must switch end to end**

### Basic Baggo Scoring

A game = 21 points

3 points for each bag in the hole; this is called a BAGGO

1 point for each bag on the board

NO SKUNKS (11-0)

Score is the difference of team totals

\*Example: #1 team with 1 bag in the hole = 3 points

#2 team with 2 bags on the board = 2 points

Score for the 1st round for #1 team = 1 point

A team does not have to hit 21 exactly to win (must win by 2 points).

NOTE: Any bag resting on the ground is worth 0 points. However, a bag resting partially on the board and partially on another bean bag (without touching the ground) is a legal toss worth 1 point.

### Crystal Frolics Tournament (Pool Play)

Rock, Paper, Scissors will determine which team throws first

**NEW for 2011 – Winning team also decides which side of the board/end they throw from**

**The losing team then may pick who they throw against. (Applies to only first game of each match)**

The winning team from each game has the honor of tossing first in the next game

Scoring: Games will be played to 21 (Must win by 2 points)...do not have to hit 21 exact

Matches consist of 3 games and will last approximately 30 minutes. You will be given 30 minutes to complete your match. After 20 minutes if you have not started your third game, lighting round format will take affect. Which means all points will count, and they will no longer cancel out.

Your team will receive 1 point for a Win and 0 points for a Loss

Total wins and losses will be totaled up after pool play. Top two teams from each pool will advance to the single elimination playoff CHAMPIONS BRACKET. Bottom two teams from each pool will advance to the single elimination playoff CONSOLATION BRACKET. This will happen regardless of record. (Example: If the 3<sup>rd</sup> place team in Pool D has a better record than the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team in Pool A, the 3<sup>rd</sup> place team from pool D still will go to the consolation bracket)

Because the top 4 teams will have byes we will be seeding teams after the pool play. Below are the criteria that will be used to seed.

TIE BREAKER: #1 Overall Record

#2 Point Differential

- On the scorecard you will add up total points from your 3 games. We will then take the difference to determine the point differential of that match. Points will be accumulated throughout pool play using this method.

#3 Pull Cards: Ace Low/King High – All teams tied at this point will pull a card.

## **Crystal Frolics Tournament (Tournament Play)**

Higher seeded team will throw first and decide which side of the board/end they throw from.

Scoring: Games will be played to 21 (Must win by 2 points)

Matches will be best of 3 matches (meaning first team to 2 wins will advance)

The winning team from each game has the honor of tossing first in the next game

**NEW for 2011 – after each game in a match is complete partners must switch end to end**

### **General Info:**

- Your team roster can consist of (min. 2/max. 4); 2 who play in the game and 2 as substitutes. All four players may play throughout the course of the match. (The two players who start the game must finish, but teams can rotate the next game.)
- When playing, team partners must stand directly across from each other...meaning one will always throw from the right side of the board, and the other from the left side. Once you start the game on your side you must remain there until the game concludes. After each game in a match is complete partners must switch end to end.
- This is an adult tournament; there are no restrictions on the gender of each player. However they must be 18+ to participate.
- All points will go towards final standings and seeding in single elimination playoffs.
- Top three teams (CHAMPIONS BRACKET) will win a Gift Certificate to Buffalo Wild Wings in Crystal. Winner of the CONSOLATION BRACKET will win a Gift Certificate to Buffalo Wild Wings in Crystal.
